Practice sessions will involve

Pointing - At 6 8 & 10 metres to use a circle and get people to aim to get inside

Shooting – At 6 7 8 9 & 10 metres to aim to shoot out a boule by aiming for 2 feet in front of it, with more power

We will also use the practice piste to get used to the different types of terrains we could encounter.

Malc & Phil are already shooters but to try Brian, John & Martin and anybody else who wants to have a go.

Once we have practiced this we will put what we have learned in a game, using the rules,

where some are really different to what we are used to. We have to make sure we know these or we may potentially lose points. We need to get everyone to throw over arm and to look for a landing spot and to rub out a mark each time

Match strategy

On picking a team I will bring in 1st & 2nd reserves, who must be available.

When we arrive for a home or away match we need to practice. For an away match, the practice will involve Malc & Phil assessing the pistes then they will do the shooting with everyone else pointing.

We need to use a team strategy whereby we have for each Pairs and Triples game a leader who will advise his players where to put their boules and for people to assess their own shots. These people will be Phil, Malc, Roger, Brian and Ken. We could sometimes try people in a different order if things aren't working out

The shooters need to decide when to shoot and to retain one boule
